SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

The change of seasons is always an opportune time to marvel at the magnificence of the natural world of which we are a part. Its colours, its textures, its smells all reflect the limitless imagination of the creator. Perhaps the most marvellous feature of the world is the interconnectedness of all the elements of which it consists. Somehow the spirit of the creator is manifested through each and every aspect of this universe. And we are part of it all. The universe may be as a grain in the balance or a drop of morning dew, but each grain and each drop contains within it the possibilities of the future.

Offering hospitality is a profound social act. When we offer hospitality, we invite another into our world, into our lives. We shift our attention from our own cares and concerns to the needs and comfort of the other. By the act of hospitality we transform strangers into friends and intimates, just as Jesus did with Zacchaeus. The hospitality that Jesus offers dissolves all constraints. Relationships disregard the biased measures of propriety, forging bonds of reconciliation and issuing everyone an invitation to intimacy. The hospitality that Jesus offers recreates the world from one of insider versus outsider to one of universal inclusivity. Sinners become friends, the lost are found, and all are restored to the rightful place as children not merely of Abraham but of God. The creativity of the creator is matched by the compassion of the re-creator.

Important Notice – Safeguarding Essential Online Training for All Our Parish Volunteers

As an important part of our commitment to child safety, all volunteers in ministries and groups of our parish, are **required** to complete a 30-minute **Safeguarding Essential Online Training Module**.

The purpose of this training is to provide our volunteers with:

- foundational knowledge that will help volunteers to perform their roles.
- a clear understanding of their duty of care and of expectations with regards to safeguarding children, young people and adults from all forms of abuse and harm.

This will be:

- an annual requirement for all volunteers
- possible to complete individually online

At the completion of the training:

- volunteers will receive a certificate of completion
- the parish will also receive notification that the module has been completed successfully.

How to get started

- to access the online training go to: www.safeguarding.melbournecatholic.org
- to login, each volunteer will need their unique Working with Children Check ID and an email address.

To register, **volunteers** will need to select their **parish** from the dropdown menu as their Primary Organisation of Service.

Each registered user will receive:

- a certificate via email, once the quiz has been successfully completed.
- an annual reminder to complete the course.

Our parish will also be organising a group session for those volunteers who are unable to complete the online training. Group sessions will be on 17 November, Thursday at 6:20pm in the Church, and also on 13 and 20 November, Sunday at 10:30am.

The importance of training volunteers has been articulated in the Victorian Child Safe Standards, the National Catholic Safeguarding Standards and the National Principles for Child Safe Organisations on which the CAM Safeguarding and Wellbeing Policy for Children and Young People is based.
